KYI has eontinued to ignore hundreds of letters of proteat agoinvt this poliey and refased to soet with roaponalble losders of the eomanity.

The Besergency Cowaitteo on KrI and its suesossor orguaisntion, the Culiforain Coumittee for Nedio Freedom, hes charged thet Earle C. Authony, owner and prinelpal stocichayeer of KyI,
 Poter de Lins and Ian Be2tor, That this charge was not without foundesion mas provad in testimony given by otr. Anthony himenes dusing an FCC hparing in this oity on Mny 21, 2946.

During erose-exasination at that hearing, Mr. Anthony hai no better reczon for dropsing Sea Bnater then so sey that that consumtator'g oplatons could be "bought"-an phony and frresponabile cocupation that cleariy revenia Hr. Anthony'g blas ngalngt Baltor.

There is nothlag thut Balter, Vilder or do Lian sald on KFI which offended publie moruls or decenoy. Thero is nothing they said that ein be proved to be other then fnetual oomentary.

Yet Mr. Anthony atoted on the atend that he disohnugod thope swh "beenuse we con't control what they soo going to any and the atektion ean get indiuteh."

Mr. Anthony ${ }^{2}$ s antl-labor blas is noll known, The roport of the La FolletterCownittee on Bduestion and Labor revasie that Mr. Anthony was one of the hewriest contributors to the Southern Colifornienc, Inc., an organization crested by ouployer eroupe to socure onactiont of anti-labor logialation. Wow, Buitor, do Kian and Wilder were not enti-labor. Stor wero they anti- Mow Doul, sa wes Mr. Anthony, who rafueed to carry one of Frosident Roosorelt's fireside chets. Baltex, de Lhan and 位ldor supportod the people's progras sdroentod by Proaldeas Rooserelt. They were intereated in what the groat aafority of people in the comntry were interested iny namely, a better life for the rank and file of our citizean. It is olear that IIr. Anthony digngroed with that progron and the men on his atetion who advocated it.

Mr. Anthony hes proved by his words and aetions that in the operation of his atation, he is motivatad by personsi and political prefudices. He hsa further proved, by his arrogence and derianee of the pubile interest, that he is not worthy of apmaing the ramponsibility of operating one of the most yoserful. radio stations in the United States. For these rasaons, this comaittee beliereg thst a renewel ileense should be denied Etation KFI.
